It has been quite a journey from the founding of the foundation in 2012 to present, with a fair share of highs and heart rending challenges.

Our first batch of grade four students had the opportunity to do their first National Exams and the results have been very promising despite the many obstacles. These results are appended for your perusal and historical purposes. We hope to repeat this excellence when the graduating Grade 6 class of 2020 do their first National Exams. Academic excellence is only part of the holistic development that the management keenly keeps an eye on, as we continue to mold these young teenagers, from a deprived background to take on the world. We sincerely feel that we have contributed to their well-being not only for the present but the future as well.

As we move on to completing a decade of operations, Fatima and I are well on our way in our second 5 year strategic plan , of managing at Macro level with key appointments at managerial level in place. At our last board meet younger board members and an Executive Committee (EC) were appointed to take on the increasing workload with even more energy.

I am pleased to inform that the 2016 – 2021 five year master plan on capital expenditure is 80% complete. These all have been financed by donors. The Board had decided not to go ahead with Secondary education at present due to the acute shortage of well trained teachers. Thus a plan was presented to opt for a Teachers Training College (TTC) to take off in early 2021. Unfortunately, the Covid crisis has set us back financially as our

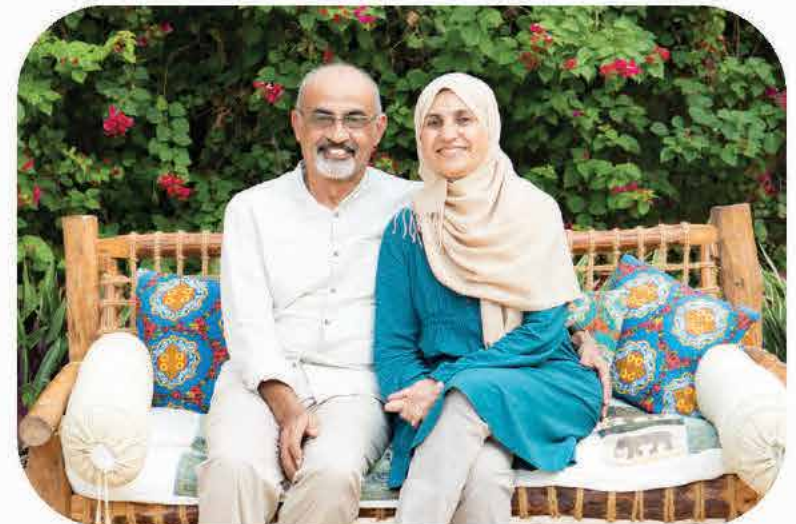
recurrent expenditure is dependent on the income from the Tamani Villas, which was virtually ground to a halt due to the travel restrictions on tourist's movement worldwide. Operations at many levels, academically and administratively, had to be adjusted to take on the challenge. We look forward to stabilizing the situation in 2021 with gradual improvement in tourist arrivals.

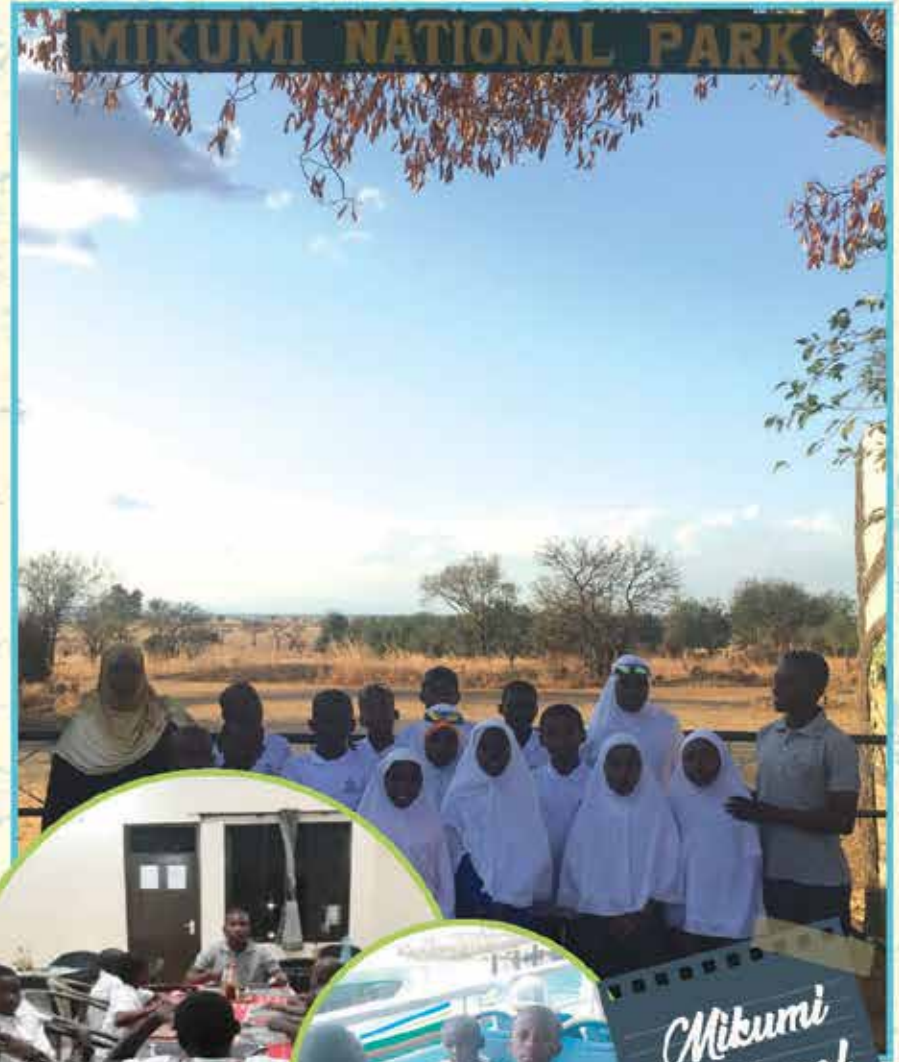

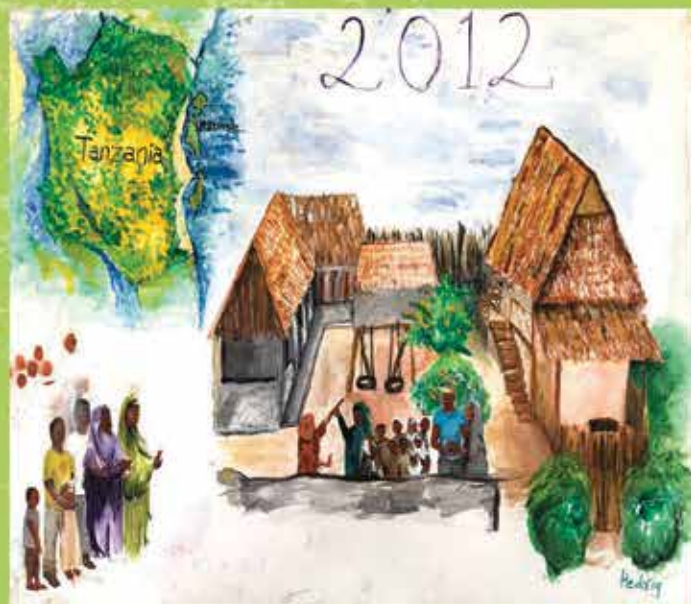
